Driving directions from Downtown Flagstaff (remember to get the combination to the lock on the site gate BEFORE you leave town)

From downtown Flagstaff, take route 66/HWY 89 north. From the Silver Saddle gas station, travel 36.0 miles to the Cemex Road, which will be on your right. You will pass Sacred Mountain trade, Antelope Hills and Wauneta Trading Post. The turn is after milepost 454. If you get to 455, you have gone too far.

Once you turn onto the Cemex Road, travel 1.6 miles. Take a right turn and go through the gate. From the last turn, travel 1.2 miles to the garden site.

General Information:

This site is on private ranchland, owned by the Babbitt Family. On your way to the site you will pass ranch buildings. The land owners are aware of our presence, however not all ranch staff may have been informed. In the unlikely event that you talk with ranch staff, please be courteous and show them your NAU id – call the SEGA staff member who you are working/coordinating with if there is a problem.
